Integrated Teacher Education Programmes (ITEP): Admission Guidelines (2025–2026) (Aligned with NEP 2020 | NCTE Recognised | Admissions through NCET conducted by NTA)

1. Introduction

Kiang Nangbah Government College, Jowai (NCTE recognised Institute) offers Integrated Teacher Education Programmes (ITEP) (align with NEP 2020) – a four-year multidisciplinary undergraduate dual degree to prepare future school teachers for the Secondary Stage (Classes IX—XII). These programmes are intended to nurture high-quality educators equipped with 21st-century skills, strong pedagogical grounding, and a deep understanding of subject content.

2. Programmes Offered

- (i) B.A.B.Ed. (Arts Stream Secondary Stage)
- (ii) B.Sc.B.Ed. (Science Stream Secondary Stage)

3. Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Academic Qualification: Candidates must have passed Class XII (10+2) or its equivalent from a recognized board with the following stream-specific eligibility:
 - (i) For B.A.B.Ed: Passed 10+2 with Arts or Humanities.
 - (ii) For B.Sc.B.Ed: Passed 10+2 with Science
- 2. Minimum Percentage: A minimum of 50% aggregate marks (45% for SC/ST/OBC/PwD) in the qualifying examination.
- **3. Important Note for Stream Transition:** Candidates from Science or Commerce backgrounds intending to pursue B.A.B.Ed must
 - (i) Appear in NCET subjects aligned with Arts/Humanities
- (ii) Ensure at least one relevant Humanities subject (e.g., History, Political Science, Economics, Geography, Languages, etc) is selected in NCET to be considered eligible.

4. Admission Requirement

- (i) Admission is strictly based on merit in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- (ii) Candidates must apply for the NCET 2025 and appear in subjects that align with their intended ITEP programme.
 - (iii) NCET scores from previous years (2023, 2024) are not valid for 2025 admissions.
- (iv) The college will not accept lateral entries or stream mismatches not validated by NCET results.

5. Application Process

Step 1: Register and Appear for NCET 2025 via the NTA portal. Ensure subject selection in NCET matches the stream of ITEP you intend to pursue.

- Step 2: After the declaration of NCET results, apply to Kiang Nangbah College through the official admission portal @ kiangnangbahcollege.ac.in
- Step 3: Upload the required documents (10+2 marksheet, NCET scorecard, photograph, ST/SC/OBC/PwD/ certificate, etc.).
- Step 4: Participate in the counseling and documents verification when called for as per the college's admission schedule.
- **6. Admission Merit List:** Selection will be based strictly on NCET merit, subject to verification of eligibility and documentation.

Tie-Breaking Rules: In case of tie in NCET scores, preference will be given to

- (a) Higher marks in qualifying 10+2 examination.
- (b) Higher marks in relevant NCET subject section.
- **7. Reservation Policy:** Reservations will be as per the Meghalaya State Government norms for SC, ST, OBC, EWS, and PwD categories.

Candidates must submit valid certificates during counseling for claim of reservation.

8. Fee Structure & Scholarships

The detailed **fee structure** and **semester-wise breakdown** will be provided during counseling. Eligible students may apply for **scholarships** under various **Central and State Government schemes**.

- 9. Refund Policy
- 1. Application Fee: Non-refundable, under any circumstances.
- 10. Important Instructions for Applicants
- (i) Admission is provisional until verification of all documents.
- (ii) NCET 2025 is **mandatory** for all applicants and subjects must **align with the chosen ITEP** stream (Arts/Science).
- (iii) Only applicants selecting Kiang Nangbah Government College as a preferred institution in their application will be considered.
- (iv) Admission is non-transferable to any other institution/programme.
