

NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the resolutions of the Academic Council in its 90th and 91st meetings held on 11th March, 2014 and 3rd June, 2014, respectively and the Executive Council in its 157th meeting held on 17th June, 2014, it is hereby notified for all concerned that:

1. **The Semester System at the Under Graduate level in all Colleges affiliated to the University shall be implemented from the academic session 2015-16.**
2. **With the implementation of the semester System:**
 - (i) the affiliation status of Colleges may be upgraded from Pass to Honours in respect of Colleges that are offering any subject as Pass Course only. Such Colleges may be given grace period of 3 (three) years to confirm the criteria prescribed for affiliation of Honours Course.
 - (ii) a student shall have to clear the Degree within 5 (five) academic years or 10 (ten) semesters.
 - (iii) students are eligible to proceed to the next semester course, regardless of passing or failing in any one or more subjects of the first five end semester examination(s). Such candidates will be required to appear and pass the failed subjects between 7th to 10th semester only (or within 5 years) and not during Regular Semesters i.e. III to VI.
 - (iv) students appearing for improvement examinations will be governed under the same provision but required to surrender their original marks. Marks obtained consequent upon improvement examinations will be retained.



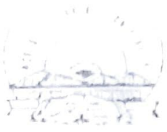

Revised Syllabus of the B.Com. V Semester
English Course

Full Marks: 100

External Marks: 75

Continual Assessment: 25

The objective of the course is to equip the students with a comprehensive knowledge of literature in the form of prose and poetry and also give them hands on training in composition. The Business Communication segment is divided into three components: the internal, the external and the electronic communications. It aims to build expertise in students in the various fields of communication. Section I comprises Prose, Poetry and Composition. Therefore Prose and Poetry Sections of the syllabus are allotted 15 (fifteen) marks each with 10 marks for descriptive and 5 marks for short answers respectively. The Composition portion is allotted 10 marks. Section II comprises Business Communication which is divided into three parts and marks are allotted in the following manner:

1. External Communication : 7+8=15 marks (2 Questions)
2. Internal Communication : 5+5=10 marks (2 Questions) However, questions set on Letters of termination and dismissal will have full 10 marks for a single question. The section will contain two questions of 5 marks each on Show Cause Notices and Charge sheet or a single question of 10 marks on Letters of Termination and Dismissal.
3. Electronic: 10 marks (1 Question).

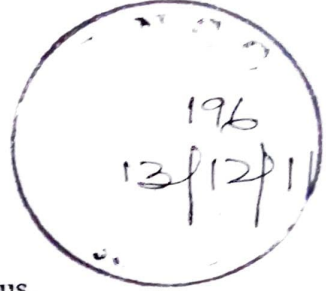

SEMINAR

The Seminar shall be conducted internally by the Department of Chemistry of the respective Colleges. There shall be no external examiner, but the Seminar shall be conducted formally latest by the end of October each year. A Report of the same along with the marks awarded shall be sent to the Examinations Department on or before 30th November every year.

The Topic of the Seminar shall be decided by the Department and informed to the student at least 30 (thirty) days ahead of the exact date of the Seminar. Each student shall choose a topic in consultation with the Department. The topics must be from any of the subjects of contemporary interest in Chemistry. Students must submit a Write-up of the Seminar.
