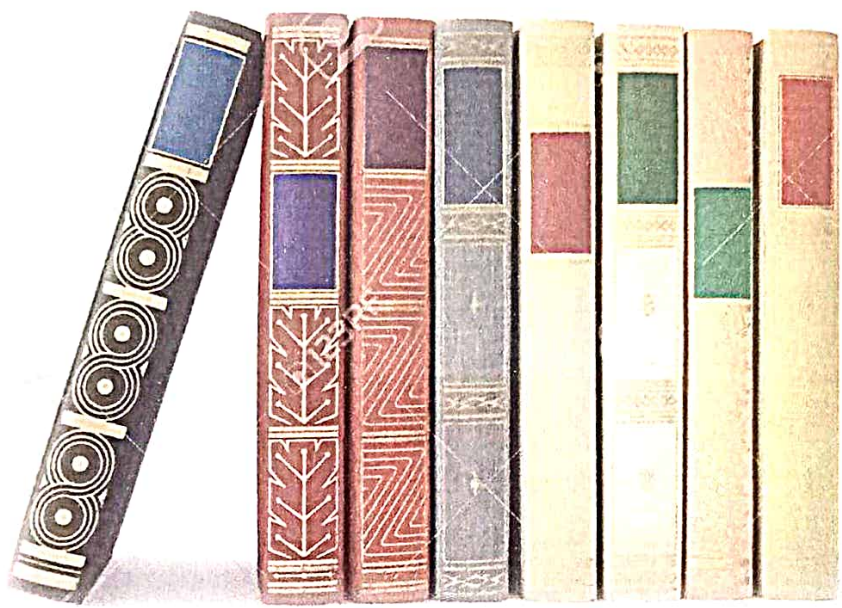

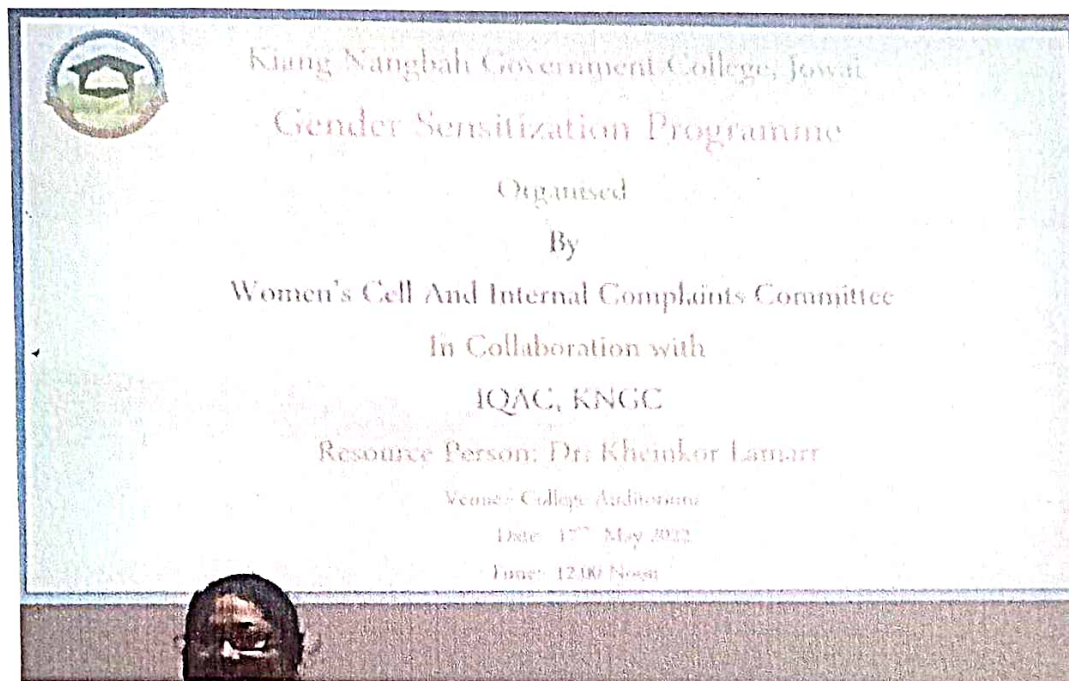

Women's Cell and Internal Complaints Committee in Collaboration with IQAC, Kiang Nangbah Government College, Jowai organized a one day programme on "Gender Sensitization" on 17th May, 2022. The programme began at 12.00 noon with an introduction to the dignitaries on the dais by the Chairperson of the programme, Smt. T. Lyngdoh, Member Secretary, Women's Cell, Kiang Nangbah Government College, Jowai. The dignitaries on the dais were Dr. Kheinkor Lamarr, Asst. Prof, Khadar Doloi Law College, Dr (Mrs) E. M. Blah (Principal) KNGC, Dr J. P. Sharma, IQAC Coordinator, KNGC and Dr S. Nongkhlaw, Assoc. Prof, Dept of Education, KNGC. The Chairperson then introduced the theme of the Seminar "**Gender Sensitization**" and highlighted the sensitivity of the topic. Further, a brief introduction on the topic was brought out particular in regards to male and female roles as construed by the society.

The welcome speech was delivered by Dr (Mrs) E. M. Blah (Principal) KNGC, Jowai. A special welcome was addressed to the distinguished Speaker, Dr Kheinkor Lamarr, Asst. Prof, Khadar Doloi Law College, Resource Person of the day's programme. Opening remarks on Gender Sensitization was also shared by Dr (Mrs) E. M. Blah. She highlighted that Gender Sensitization involves creating awareness about gender roles and working toward creating an environment of gender justice where men and women can work together with a sense of personal security and dignity. She mentioned that gender awareness is important because it is one of the requirements for the normal development of an individual. She emphasized the behaviour that avoids discrimination based on gender. The Principal then expressed her gratitude to the Women's Cell and Internal Complaints Committee, KNGC in collaboration with IQAC for organising the Seminar. A warm welcome was extended to all the participants of the programme with the hope that the students will benefit and enrich themselves with the knowledge after completion of the events.

The Subject Expert, Dr Kheinkor Lamarr, Asst. Prof, Khadar Doloi Law College dwelt in detail about gender sensitization. Her lecture started with the meaning of gender in principle and the differences between 'gender' and 'sex'. It informed the audience of the primary objective of gender sensitization and about how it helps individuals to examine their personal attitudes and beliefs and questioning the realities of sexes. She emphasised being empathetic to another gender which will ultimately stop discrimination on the basis of gender. She also explained the need for gender sensitization and highlighted the problems and concerns that arise from this issue. Gender Bias in Education, The Gender Pay Gap, Poor Access to Health care, Lack of Representation for Women and Girls at the Policy Level and Gender Based Violence were the problem areas which were highlighted and discussed in detail. Finally, the resource person talked about the legal provision available under Article 3

of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights which undertakes to ensure equal rights of all men and women at the International level. Further, at the National level, emphasis was made with regard to the Fundamental Rights of the Indian citizen under Articles 14, 15, and 16 where it states clearly the *Right To Equality* and that there should be no discrimination on the basis of gender. The Supreme Court ruling in 2014 which decriminalized LGBT Community was also highlighted. Against the backdrop of these legal provisions, the participants were called to help in combating gender-related problems as well as raising awareness in women and men about gender equality.



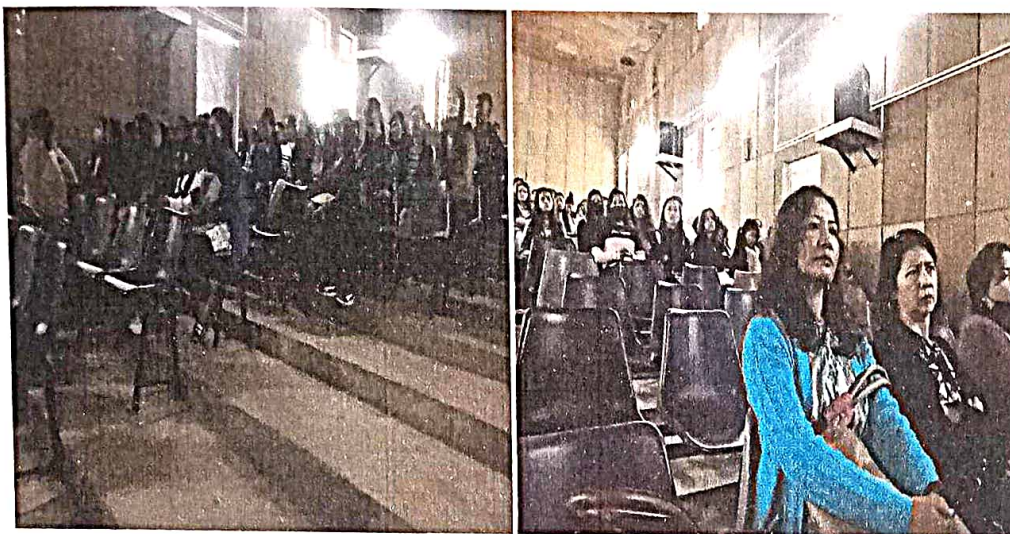
