An Exposure Trip to UmRupa mineral water producing unit at Kynshi Village, West Khasi Hills District, Meghalaya on

Forty-two students of B. Com 6th semester, 2022 participated in the tour. The team was led by two teachers.

Students interacted well with the manager of the factory. As we know, we cannot live without water. People in villages depend on springs, streams, ponds and other natural sources of potable water, hundred percent in their life time till recently. In recent years, majority of villages have also been getting water through pipe system provided by Government department, the PHE.

It is for decades now that we depend on bottled water known as mineral water when we travelled from one place to another. Such drinking water has been the product of big well-known companies which were already in business for a long time.

In the last few years some local entrepreneurs also entered this mineral water market in the state. One of them is UmRupa industrial unit and it is located at Kynshi village of West Khasi Hills District of Meghalaya. It was said that this unit was set up there because of the availability of clean water from clean source.

While interacting with the manager, it was learned that

- a. Investment made = Rs 3 crores
- b. Number of workers employed = 40
- c. Total output produced per day = 3500 cases (70,000) bottles.
- d. Sale per day = 3500 cases
- d. Cost per unit (per bottle) = Rs. 5.00P
- e. Selling price = Rs. 6.00/bottle
- f. Material used (bottles) = 5 tons per weak




