A FIELD TRIP REPORT OF KHASI DEPARTMENT TO SOHRA TOURIST SPOT ON 9TH JUNE 2022

INTRODUCTION:-

On the 9th June 2022, 19 students of B.A 6th Semester(Khasi Hons) accompanied by Smt M.Chyne Associate Professor and Smt.B.Laloo, Assistant Professor of Khasi Department of Kiang Nangbah Govt. College Jowai went to Sohra tourist spot with an objective to expose the students to some of the tourist spots located in the area which have the historical myths foretold by our great grandfather.

OBJECTIVE:-

The objectives of the trip was to let the students of the college know more about the tourist spot in terms of its historical myths, maintenance of the area, employment & income generation of the villager etc.

FIELD VISIT:

7.00A.M. – 11.00A.M.

A trip was started at 7.00A.M. from the College compound and reach safely the first tourist spot known as 'THANGKARANG PARK' located at Sohra at 11.00A.M. Visiting the park begins just after having lunch outside the park. The time spend in the park was about two hours and lots of lesson have been learned by the students.

1.00P.M – 3.15P.M.

Proceeding from Thangkarang Park at 1.00P.M. and reach the another tourist spot at 2.30P.M. known as 'DAINTHLEN' waterfall. Here, the student saw the remains of 'U THLEN' which according to the historical myths it was cut by the forefathers at that particular place, the story which was written by the Khasi authors. The time spend in the area was about 45 minutes.

3.15P.M. – 4.50P.M.

Moving from Dainthlen waterfalls at 3.15P.M. reaching another tourist spot known as 'WEI SAWDONG' waterfall at 3.40P.M. Though the area was very rough in term of its topography, the students was very pleased because they witness the nature gifted spot on our state which attract many tourists from different parts of our country and abroad. The time spend in the spot was about one hour and ten minutes.


4.50P.M. – 6.30P.M.

Moving from Wei Sawdong waterfall at 4.50P.M. reaching the last spot of the day known as 'KA BRI KI SHYNRANG' at 5.20P.M. This place was very different and unique in term of its location which is hard to find in the land of Hynniewtrep hynniewskum(Khasi land). This gifted land attract many tourist witnessing the beauty of nature. The time spend in the area was about one hour and forty minutes.

From the above field trip the students as well as the Associate & Assistant Professor having so much fun as well as learned a lots from the tourist spot located at Sohra because of its unique nature which have a historical myth foretold as read in the Khasi Books.
