Established in 1967, Kiang Nangbah Government College, the erstwhile "Jowai Government College" is a premier institution of higher education in the West Jaintia Hills District of Meghalaya.

Located in a vast and well-maintained campus conducive to academic activities, the College offers Courses in Arts (Day and Morning Sections), Science & Commerce (Day section only), and Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for B.A.B.Ed & B.Sc. B.Ed.

The College campus contains a football field, two basketball courts, Indoor Stadium and a multipurpose hall which samples facilities to its students for extra-curricular activities. It has 15 Departments in all, with a staff strength of about 181 (117 Teaching and 64 support staff). The College at present caters to over 4000 students including the Morning Section.

ADMISSION PROCESS TO ITEP COURSES

(B.A.B.Ed & B.Sc.B.Ed) one unit (50 seats) each:

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates must fulfil the following criteria to apply for this programme:

1. General category candidates with at least 50% mark in aggregate or an equivalent grade after successful completion of Standard XII/HSSCL from recognized Board(s)/Universities/. Relaxation is 5% for ST/SC and OBC Candidates.
2. Students must have appeared in NCET 2023.
3. Only those candidates whose name of the institution (Kiang Nangbah Government College, Meghalaya) appeared in their NCET Score Card can apply.

FOR FILLING ONLINE APPLICATION

1. Eligible applicants will fill out the online application form on payment of Rs. 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred) only.

ITEP COUNSELLING

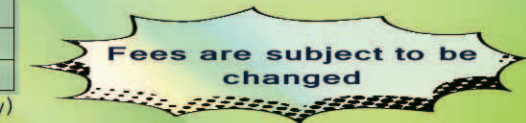

FACILITIES

LIBRARY

The Kiang Nangbah Government College Library started functioning right from the inception of the college and has been developing its collection ranging from books, periodicals, reference books, e-journals, magazines and government publications.

At present, the library consists of two main sections viz., a general section and a reference section that span a plethora of reading materials required by the students for their academic and personality development. The Library also encourages the use of Open Access Resources and provided reference and referral services for both students and teachers.



The Library is striving to automate its collection and bring in more technological advancements to effectively and efficiently serve its users and their various needs.

HOSTEL

Kiang Nangbah Govt. College, Jowai also provides Hostel facilities separately for Male (24 seats) and Female (54 seats). Hostel seats depend on the availability. Hostels are managed and run by the College authority.

The Superintendent/Warden is in-charge of the all-round maintenance, discipline and proper conduct of residents in the hostel.

The Hostel offers well furnished rooms and a number of facilities for students residing inside the hostel. Both the Hostels are located near the main College building. All Hostellers should maintain the rules and regulation of the hostel borne by the Hostel Committee.



SPORT FACILITIES

The College has various sports facilities to encourage students to participate in Sports, Games and other co-curricular activities. It has a Football Play Ground, two Basket Ball Courts, and an Indoor stadium. Time is taken off from the busy academic schedule to organize various competitions throughout the year.

Games and sports in the College is managed and run by the Sport Committee of the College. The College takes active interest in the field of games and sports and takes part regularly in different Tournament organized by different organizations.

KHELO INDIA CENTRE:

The College was selected by the Government of India as a Khelo India Centre.



COLLEGE CANTEEN

College canteen is located inside the campus where it can be easily accessed by students and staff. The Canteen is run by a Canteen Manager under the supervision of the Canteen Committee. The food items are priced at reasonable rates and cleanliness is strictly adhered to.



COLLEGE BUS

Kiang Nangbah Govt. College, Jowai provides Bus facilities for its students managed by the Transport Committee and under the advice of the College authority. Buses follow a route from Jowai town to College and back at different timings.



MULTI-PURPOSE HALL

Kiang Nangbah Government College, Jowai has a Multi-Purpose Hall with a seating capacity of 410 seats equipped with sound systems and attached washrooms for males and females and a vast surrounding area. The Multi-Purpose Hall is located at the heart of the College Campus. College activities, programs and competitions during College Week, NSS programs, Seminars, Workshops, etc., are organized from time to time.



NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The college also has a National Service Scheme (NSS) unit. The Motto of the NSS is "NOT ME BUT YOU". The sole aim of the NSS is to provide hands on experience to students in delivering community service and also to train them to have effective leadership skills in their life so as to become efficient leaders and persons who are empathetic towards others.

The NSS unit usually conducts two types of activities.

1. Regular activities- include Cleaning Drives, workshops on personality and leadership development. Awareness program on HIV and Aids and Diabetes, Observance of important national days like International Yoga Day, National Unity Day, World Environment Day, International Youth Day, blood donation, training on disaster management, etc.

2. Special Camps- the NSS unit of the college adopts a village and works according to the needs of the people of the village for e.g renovating the village school or organizing programs for the benefit of the village students. Once a village is adopted, the NSS unit will have to work for three years in the adopted village.



NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC):

The college also has a National Cadet Corps (NCC) unit. It offers opportunity for the students to enrol themselves with an aim to train and motivate the youth, provide leadership in all walks of life and be always available for the service of the nation.
