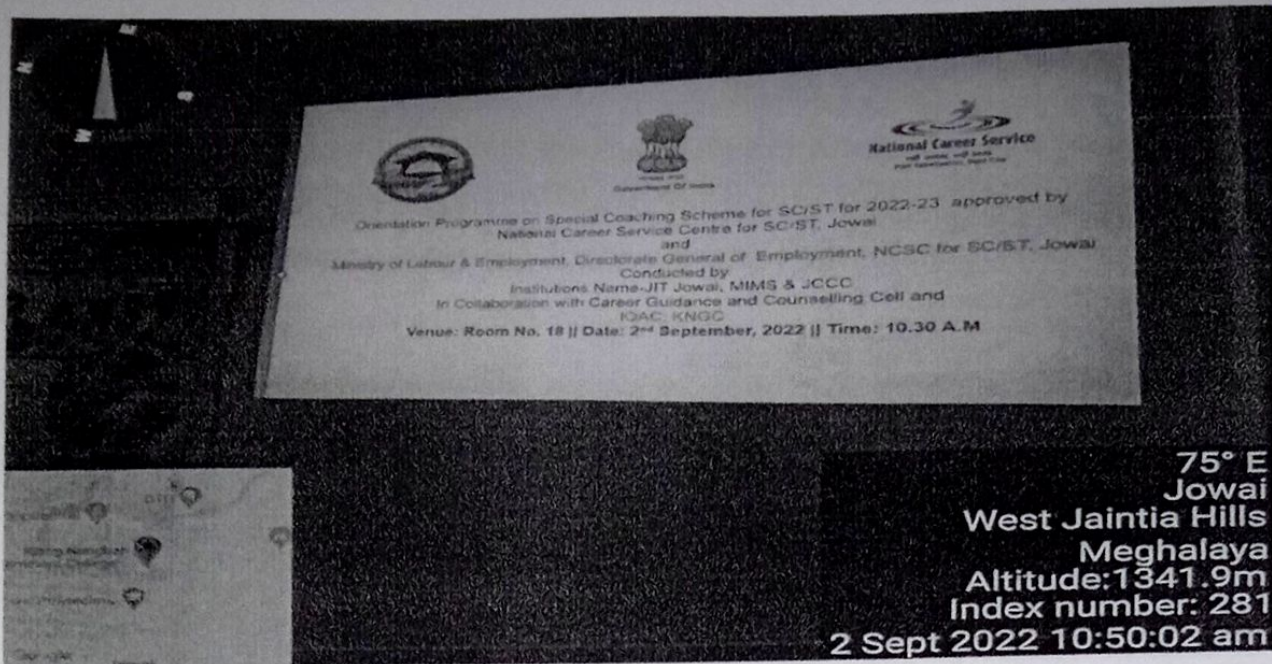

Jaintia Institute of Technology (JIT), Jowai, MIMS & Jaintia Career Coaching Centre (JCCC) in Collaboration with Career Guidance and Counselling Cell and IQAC, Kiang Nangbah Government College, Jowai organized an Orientation Programme on Special Coaching Scheme for SC/ST for 2022-23 approved by “National Career Service Centre for SC/ST, Jowai” and Ministry of Labour & Employment, Directorate General of Employment, NCSC for SC/ST, Jowai on 02nd September 2022. The programme began at 10.30 am with an introduction and a welcomed addressed by the Chairperson of the programme, Smt. S. Suja, Member Secretary, Career Guidance and Counselling Cell, Kiang Nangbah Government College, Jowai. Members on the dais were introduced which include Dr J. P. Sharma, IQAC Coordinator, KNGC, Heads of the Three Institutes, viz., Shri M.K Sharma, Proprietor MIMS, Shri. Bankitbor Marwein, the Managing Director, Jaintia Institute of Technology, Shri. Seven Dkhar, Head of Jaintia Career Coaching Centre.

The Chairperson made a brief introductory note with a short story and highlighted the importance of a career by choice and that the participants have chosen the right platform to guide them toward a better career.

The inaugural address and briefing about the National Career Service Centre with the objectives of the Programme were delivered by Dr J. P. Sharma, IQAC Coordinator, KNGC, Jowai. Five main aims and objectives of the National Career Service Centre were shared with the students which are as follows

- To enhance career and employment opportunities;
- Counselling and guidance for career development;
- Focussing on decent employment;
- Enhancing female labour force participation;
- Encouraging entrepreneurs and other courses.

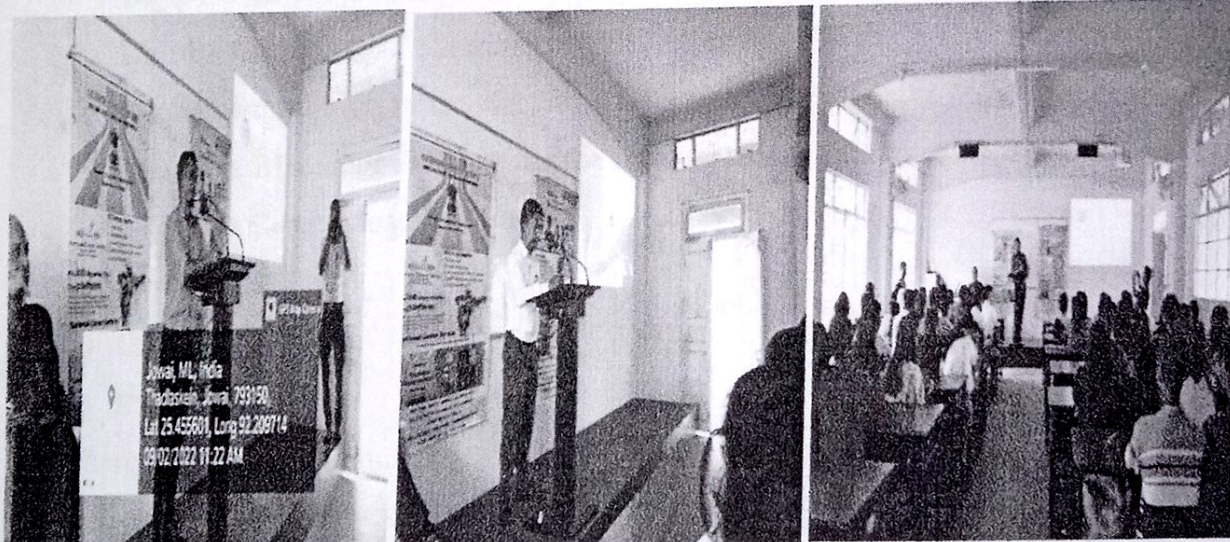
The IQAC Coordinator further highlighted that the programme in Jowai started for the first time and urge the students to visit and get themselves registered on the NCSC website to equip themselves with all the services (programmes) and benefits offered and conducted by NCSC for ST/SCs.

Attention was drawn to the fact that there are no specific programmes or courses for career guidance in Meghalaya in general and Jaintia Hills in specific. This reinforces the need to enrol in the courses offered by NCSC. The IQAC coordinator appeals to the participants to take the course seriously through these institutes and various job fairs programmes which provide free training to job seekers. He elaborated on the types of common courses offered by these institutes, in particular, General English, General awareness, Quantitative analysis, Computer proficiency, Computer fundamentals, Individual career guidance, and Group career

guidance for the job-seekers. It was also informed to the students that JIT Jowai and MIMS will be holding classes at Kiang Nangbah Government College. Finally, he highlighted that NCSC is a huge opportunity for enhancing career and employment opportunities that work for the welfare of job-seekers. The course is of eleven months and pointed out that financial assistance will be provided to students with 80% attendance in the training.

The different heads of institutions oriented the students about their service centres and the types of programmes, subjects and courses that these institutes provided. The Head of Jaintia Institute of Technology, Shri, B. Marwein emphasizes the values of hard work, cooperation, and honesty which are very important for students in present times. He spotlights soft skills as an important component of career development and through this training, the participants are prepared for the future. Further, he also encourages the students to explore other options for career development as Government jobs are not possible for everyone. With this backdrop, he advocated the need to be independent and to have a strong vision for a stable future.

The Head of Jaintia Career Coaching Centre, Shri Seven Dkhar emphasized the three Cs: 'Consistency, Commitment and Curiosity' and calls upon the students to have dreams and focus on their dreams. Shri. M. K. Sharma, proprietor of MIMS highlighted the need for mental reasoning and emphasize the importance of Computer education with special emphasis on the speed of typing.

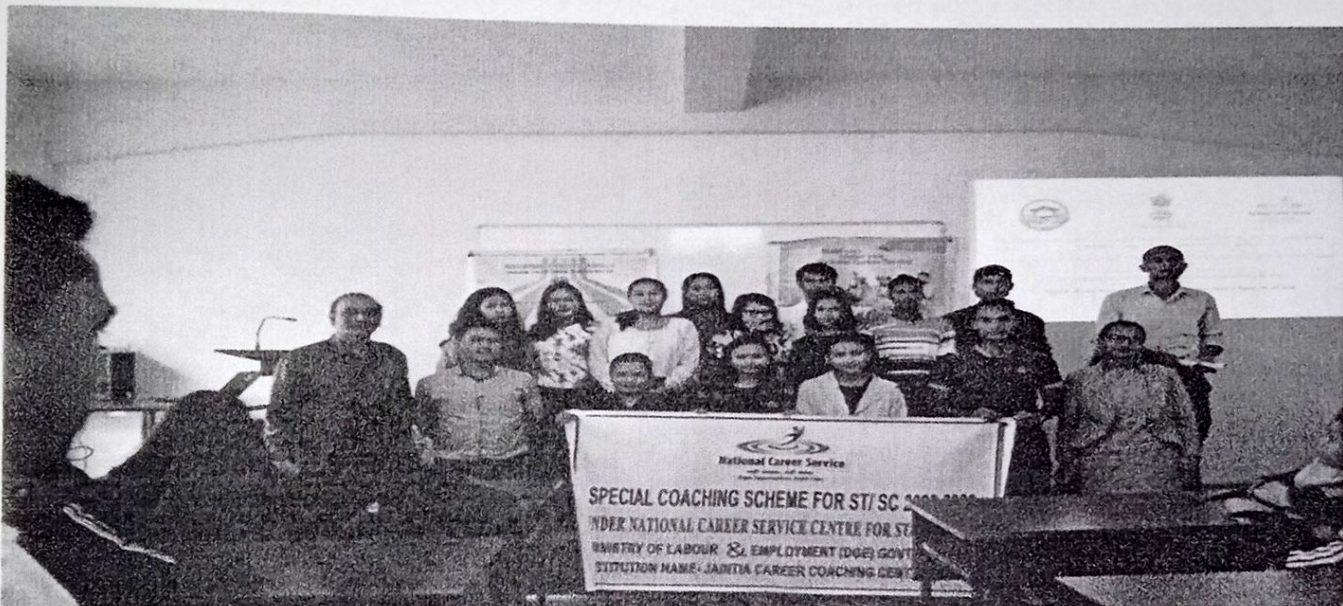

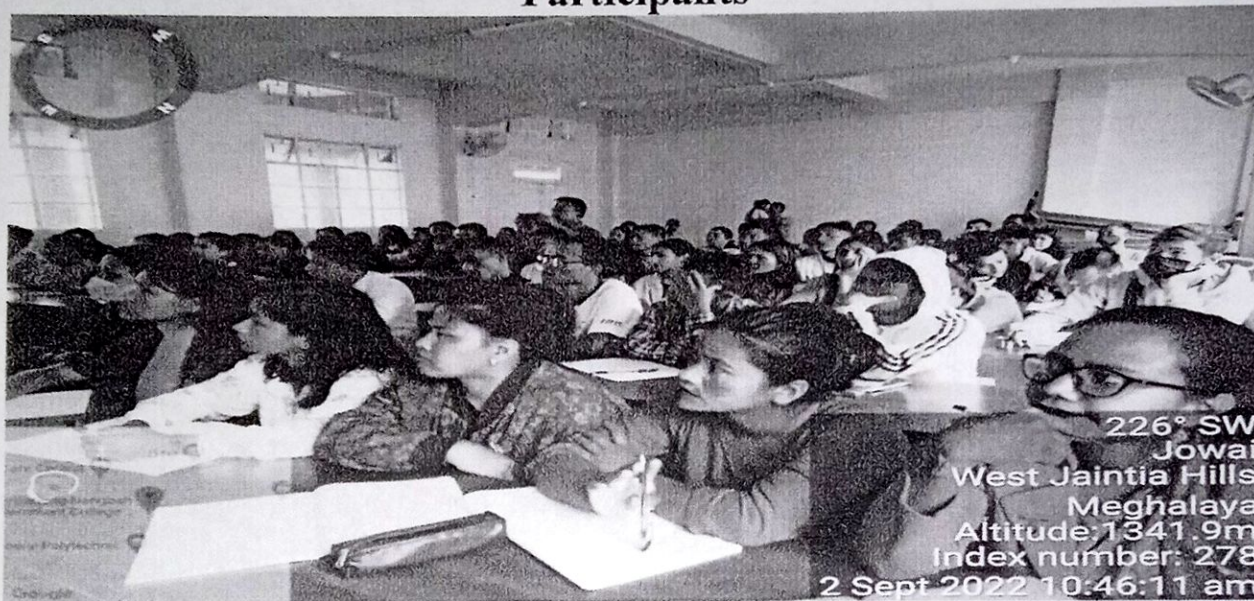
