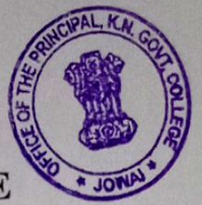

Aviation and Hospitality

REPORT

At the outset, the resource person mentioned about the importance of professional skills which will help the students in meeting the demands of enhancing the employability to work in different sectors of aviation and hospitality. She also highlighted about the different sectors of the airline industry, which includes 1. Flight crew, 2. Cabin crew, and 3. Ground staff.

Flight crew includes pilot, co-pilot, captain, etc, which are responsible for navigating the aircraft. To be a flight crew member, one must at least possess a CPL (Commercial Pilot License) in addition to other basic requirements and trainings.

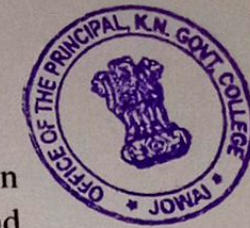
Cabin crew includes air Hostess, Flight Stewards and stewardess, who are responsible for the safety and comfort of passengers on board. To become a cabin crew member, individuals have to undergo extensive training that covers topics such as safety procedures, first aid, customer service and communication skills. They must also meet certain requirement such as height which is 5 feet 1 inch for girls and 5 feet 6 inch for boys, weight, language proficiency, and must pass background checks and medical evaluation. Minimum qualifications required for cabin crew is a class 12 passed certificate.

Ground staffs in airlines are individuals who work on the ground to ensure the smooth operation of flight and provide assistance to passengers and crew members. The Ground staffs are further divided into three categories viz. 1. Commercial 2. Sales and 3. Security where the commercial staff's job is rendering customer service such as issuing of boarding pass, baggage handling, etc. Security section sees to the aircraft maintenance and airport security at the security check point and the Sales department is mainly for generating revenue.

All the three categories require an applicant to have strong communication skills and at least be a graduate.

She also highlighted about management and hospitality which is a field of study which prepare individuals for career in the hospitality industry. The hospitality industry includes hotels, restaurant, travel and tourism, events and entertainment. Management and hospitality programme includes topics such as marketing, accounting, human resources operation, customer service and leadership.

She also informed the students that Aptech Aviation Academy Shillong offer diploma course for 4 months in hospitality and a diploma course of 6 months for cabin crew and ground staff. On the completion of the courses, the Academy will hold an online exam, where



by successful candidates will be certified by the academy and offer job placements, even though there is no job guarantee. However, assistance will be provided by the academy and recruitment will be dependent wholly upon the candidate's performance during the interview.

She concluded by encouraging students to take up any of these courses in aviation and hospitality which will help them to earn a good salary starting ₹20,000 for those who work in hospitality sector and ₹25,000 to ₹29,000 for those who work in the airlines sector. She also mentioned that in today's generation not only hard skills like computer skills and qualification for a job are required but soft skills, like communication skills, team work, and problem solving abilities are also very important in a workplace.

The program was very successful and benefited the students as well as the teachers' present.

REPORT

She concluded with the statement that “the outward appearance of a person is the first thing that catches the eye of others”. Therefore, being presentable at all times is of considerable importance.

She further added that the industry is booming and it is mainly due to the growing desire among both men and women to look stylish and feel good about themselves. The students requested Global Infotech if their branches can be opened in Jowai to enable them to enrol for the courses as to help them to be self-dependent and self-employed.

REPORT

The demand for animation, VFX and video gaming has expanded with the increase in targeted broadcasting hours by cable and satellite TV, availability of low cost internet access, penetration of mobile devices along with the growing popularity of streaming video. In addition, the rapid advancement of technology has made animation, VFX & games available to the masses, and this industry has become one of the fastest growing segments in the global media and entertainment market. We are increasingly seeing more of animation, VFX and games production taking place in a globally distributed mode. Production work is becoming global with countries as well as regions offering tax incentives, subsidies, financial support, regional low labor costs, etc. and companies are cutting costs by setting up facilities in such regions. Cloud computing is playing a key role in character rendering and modeling processes as cloud based rendering of animation films is more effective and efficient as it reduces the time and cost compared to traditional rendering.

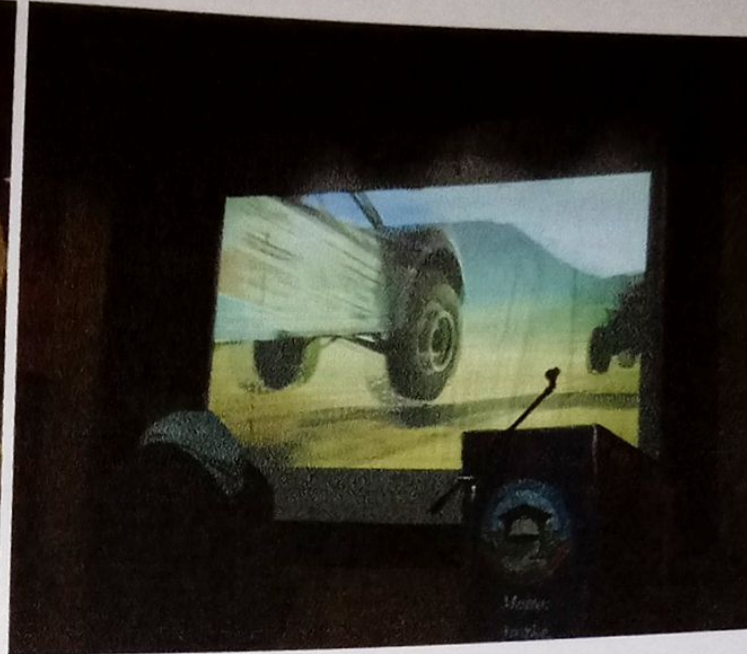
