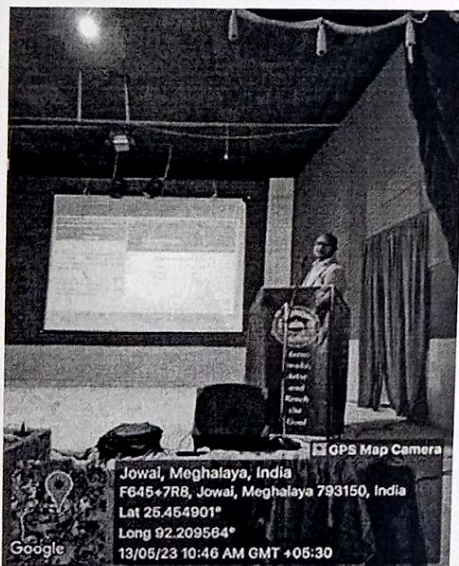




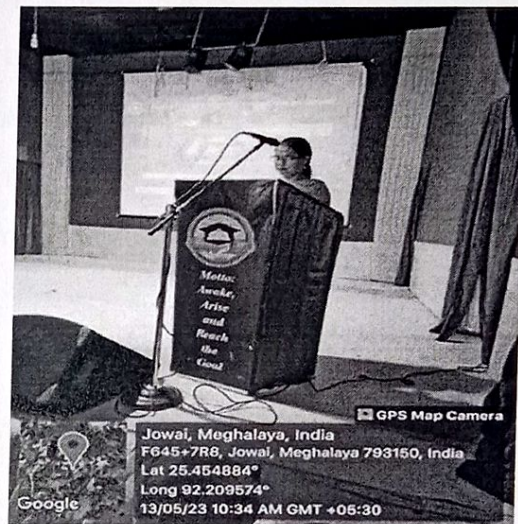
Activities of Green Campus Committee for the year 2022-2023.

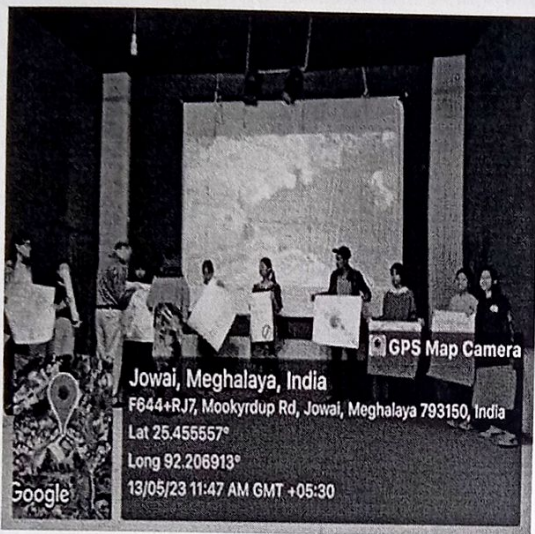

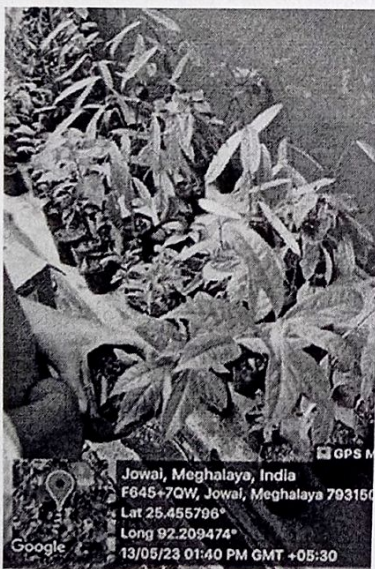
Government College was a Resource person on this day. In his talk, he mentioned that the world is being inundated by plastic. More than 400 million tonnes of plastic are produced every year, half of which is designed to be used only once. Of that, less than 10 per cent is recycled. An estimated 19-23 million tonnes end up in lakes, rivers and seas. Today, plastic clogs landfills leaches into the ocean and is combusted into toxic smoke, making it one of the gravest threats to the planet. Even more harmful is microplastics which are tiny plastic particles (less than 5mm) that result from both breakdown of larger plastics and commercial product development. Microplastics find their way into the food we eat, the water we drink and even the air we breathe. Many plastic products contain hazardous additives, which may pose a threat to our health. Realising

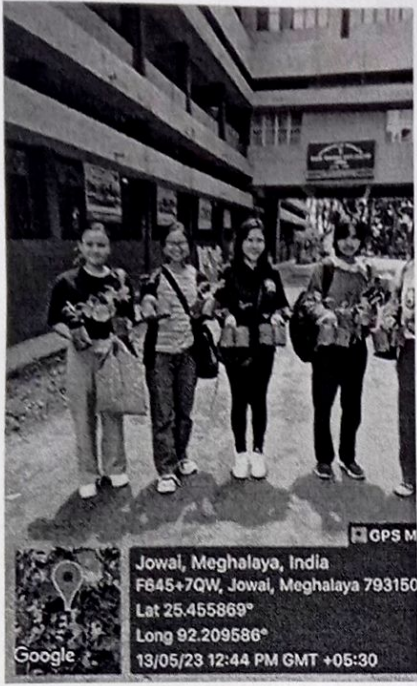
this threat from plastic pollution, the speaker explained various issues which were of utmost importance especially from an institutional perspective together with a concerted effort, is needed from individuals, governments, companies and other stakeholders to manage and solve this crisis. This underscores the importance of this World Environment Day mobilizing action from every corner of the world. World Environment Day 2023 is offering hope that one day, plastic pollution will be history.
