
## **THE Budget Session, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023.**

### **"GOVERNMENT BUSINESS"**

The Department of Political Science, Kiang Nangbah Government College Jowai attended the Meghalaya Legislative Assembly's yearly Budget Session 2023-2024, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of March, 2023 which began at 10:30 a.m. and ended at 2:00 p.m. The Sixth Semester Honours students of the department along with their respective teachers, left the college premises from Jowai at around 7.00a.m. and arrived in Shillong at 9.00 am sharp.

The administration of the office extended a warm welcome to the invitees. The students were excited because it was the first time they had seen the session in action. Sir Thomas A Sangma, the Assembly's Speaker starts the session by welcoming all present members, invitees, and other dignitaries. He convened the House for a debate on the budget session of 2023-2024. The Chief Minister, Shri C. Sangma, who was in charge of the Finance department, presented the state's deficit budget. He also give a fiscal revenue for taxation. The budget session lasted many hours because each cabinet minister under the ruling put forward their demands and allocation for the state. The educational sector has also received special attention, with the government allocating Rs.2.243,00,00,000 crore for the status of education in the state. In addition there are also other allocations for various departments in the state. The students were also informed with the government's announcement to create five lakh job opportunities with a focus on entrepreneurship, tourism, knowledge, digital services, agriculture, and related industries. It was an amazing opportunity for the students to meet the District political leaders and also witness the procession of the Budget Session.

The budget management study of the state and its allotment is a topic covered in the Syllabus's Paper 6 under Public Administration Syllabus. The students are very concerned; to know what reality is and what is under the direction of the book. The entire day was a blessing in disguise because the entire programme is designed to be successful and meaningful. Lastly, students and faculty was able to take photos with some of the dignitaries present in the session such as the Speaker, Commissioner, and local MLA of the district West Jaintia Hills. At around 8 p.m., the students safely returned home and overall it was an educational and fruitful trip.
