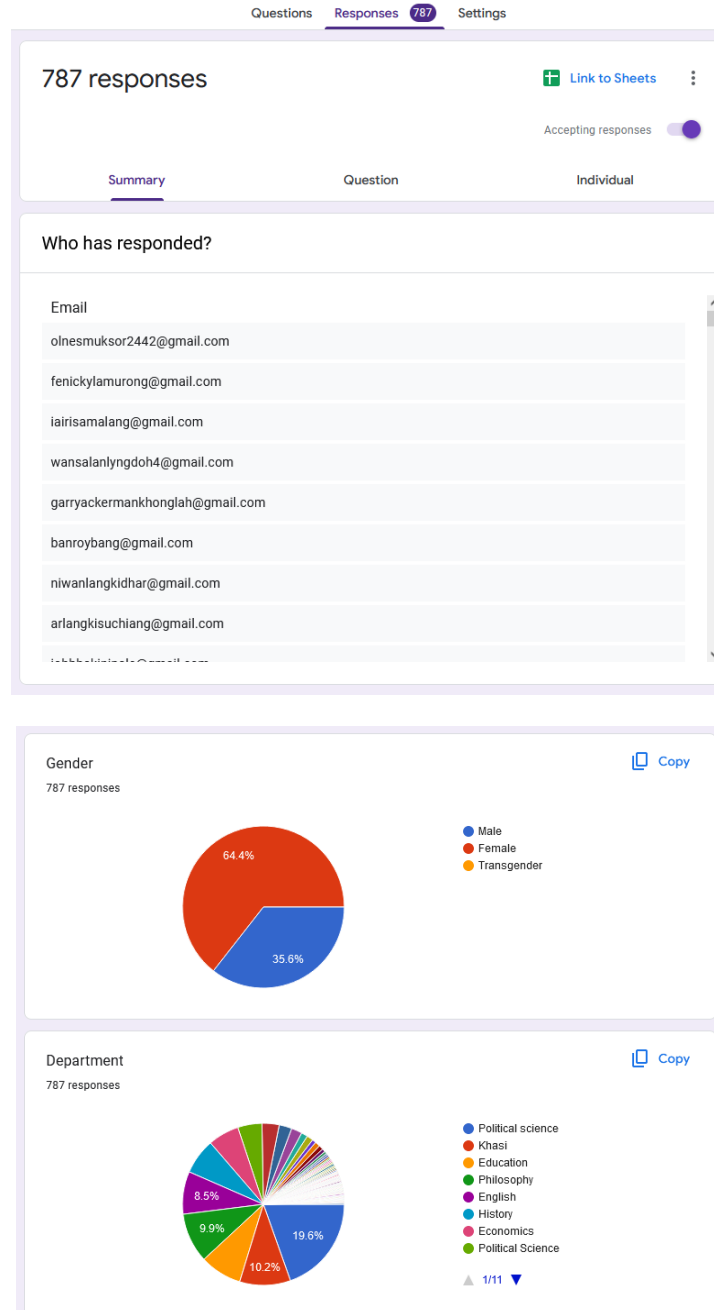

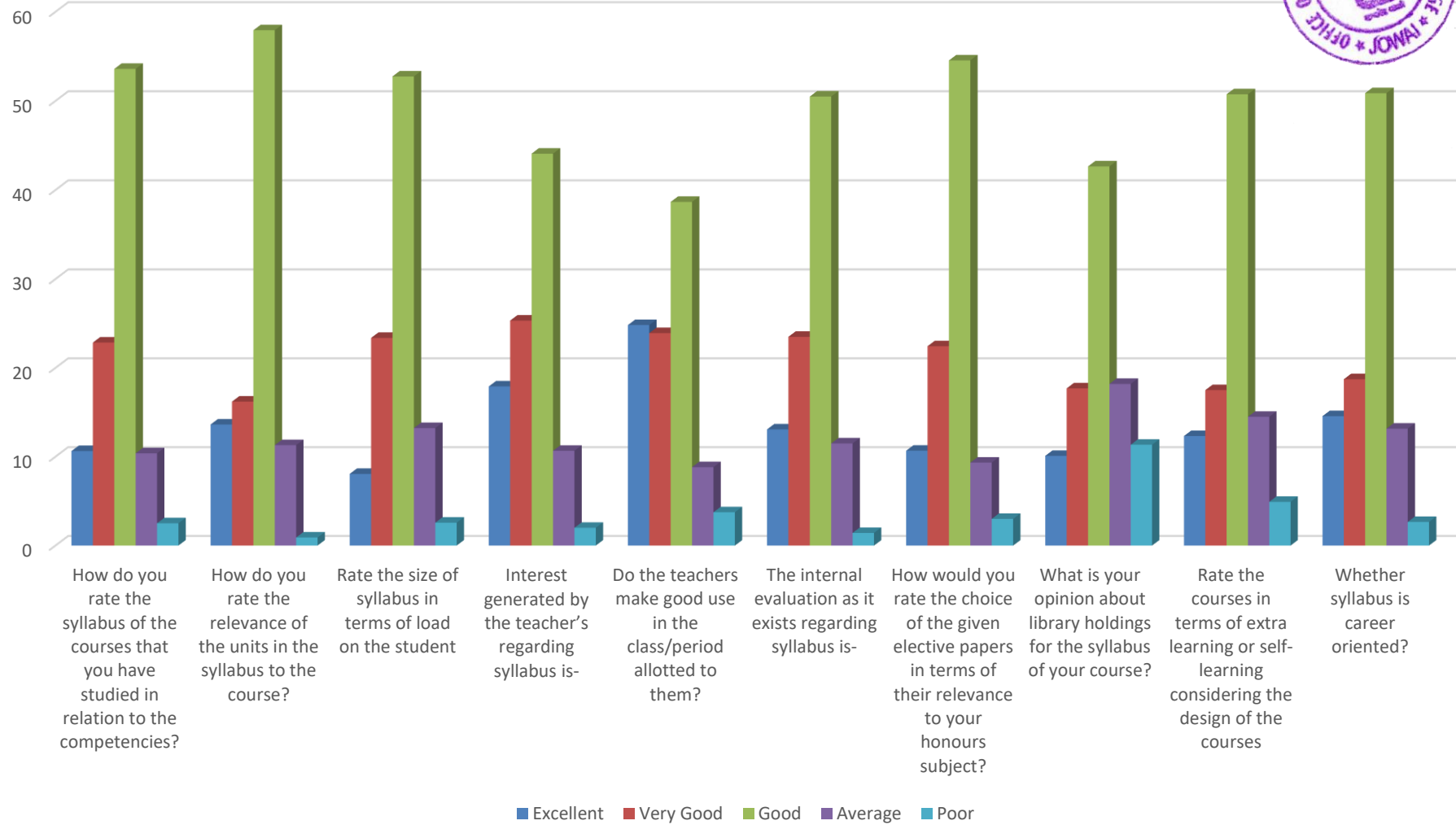

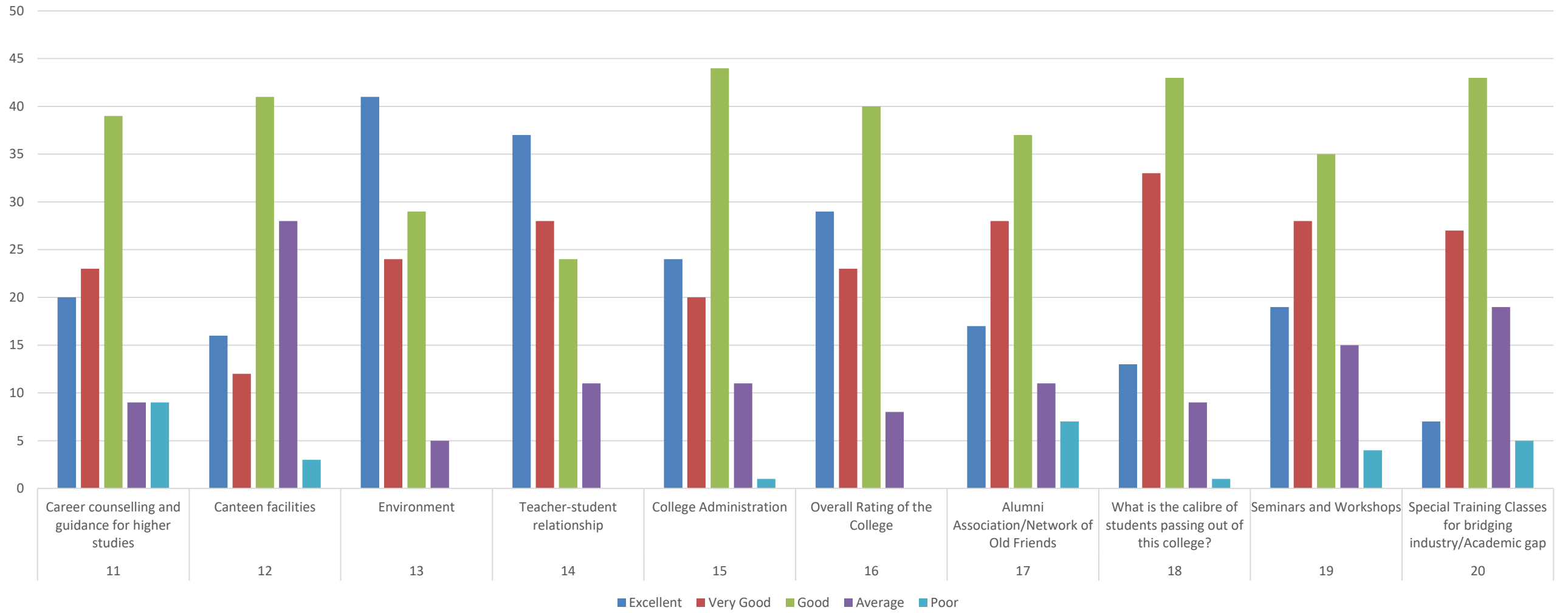


Graphical Representation of Alumni



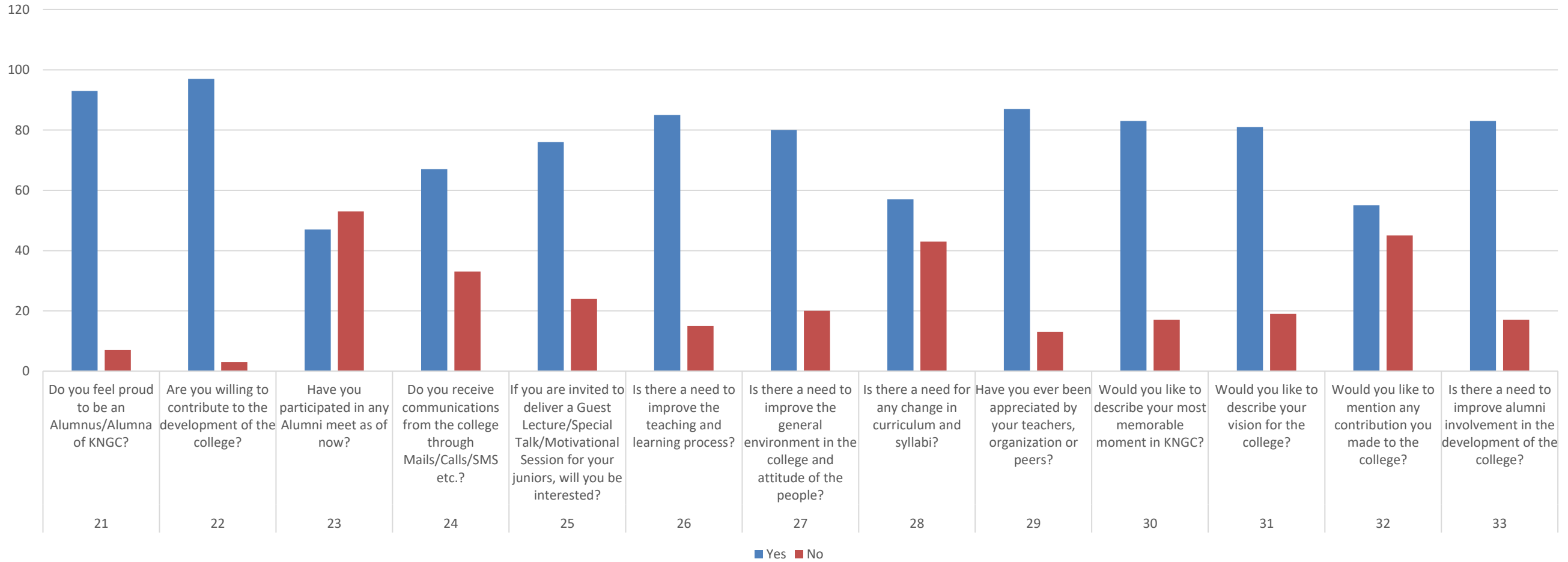


Graphical Representation of Alumni



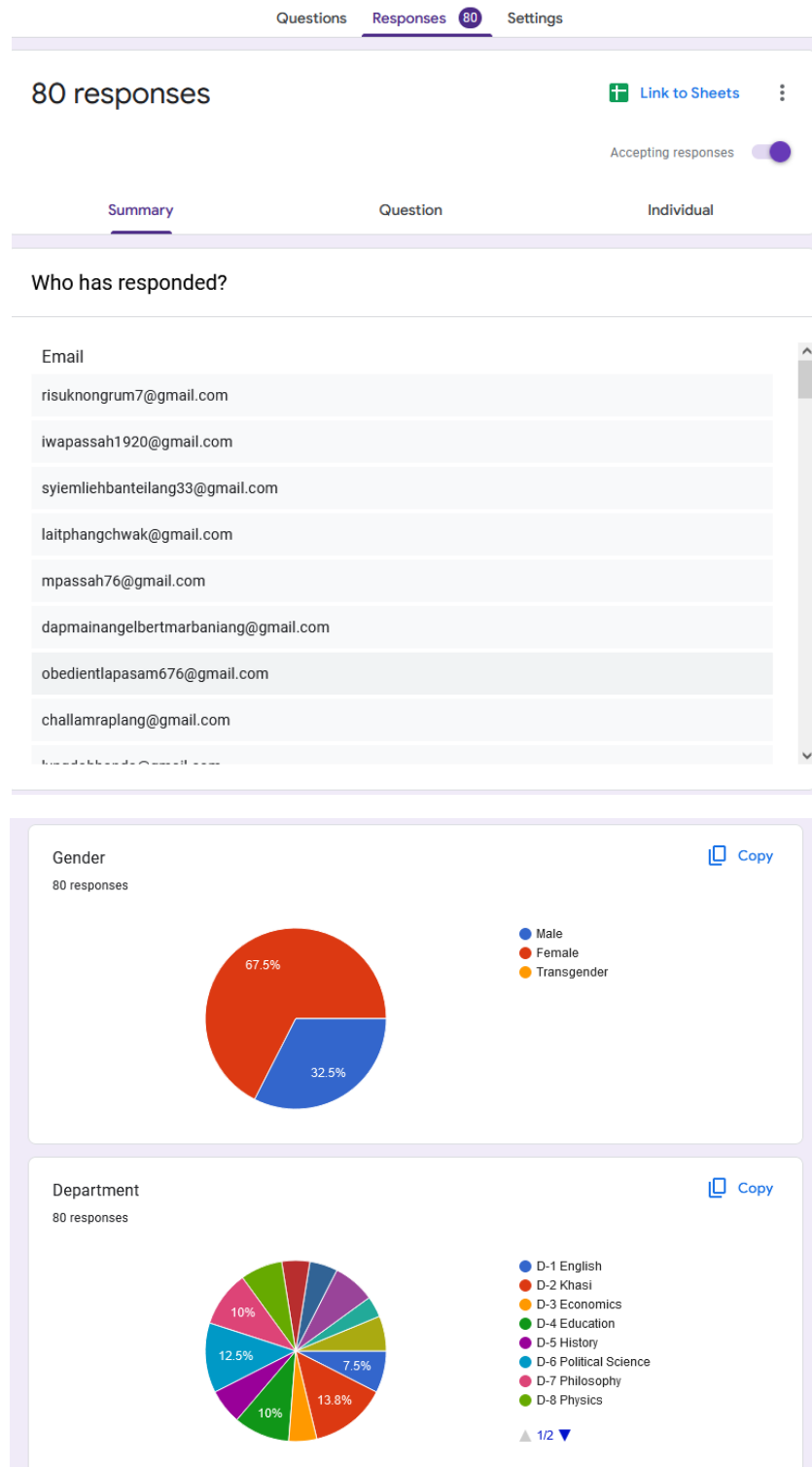

From the above table, it is seen that the overall response of teachers on the curriculum has been positive. In all the parameters, majority of the teachers rated it as **Good**.

Regarding the suggestions to improve the overall teaching-learning experience in the institution, the teachers suggested that more smart classrooms are needed, the syllabus should be relevant to today's world, more optional papers need to be incorporated in the syllabus and the learning outcome needs to be more specific and updated. More of job-oriented course/programme to be included in the syllabus.

In terms of the library, the teachers suggested that more study materials, reference books, journals are needed.
